Greetings from the ASEA-UNINET Network Office – we hope you will have been experiencing a great summer!

We would like to raise awareness of a few upcoming calls:

Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET Call 25/26 (see grant summary attached): a new call with increased grant funding is expected to open by early September 2024 with a call deadline planned on March 1st, 2025

Ernst Mach ASEA-UNINET Short-term Research Grant Call 25/26 (see grant summary attached): this programme accepts ongoing applications and is expected to (re-)open (with increased grant funding) by early September 2024!

ASEA-UNINET Project Call 2024: a new call for projects with an implementation period from January 1st, 2025 to December 31st, 2025 or to December 31st, 2026 (NEW: two-year projects within the framework of ASEA-UNINET will now also be possible) is expected to open by early September 2024 with a call deadline planned on November 4th, 2024. Further details will follow. All information about the call will be updated here.

It should be noted that applications for ASEA-UNINET projects is only to be submitted from the Austrian side. Researchers interested in an ASEA-UNINET project should be so kind and contact interested researchers at the Austrian ASEA-UNINET member universities. Kindly see: ASEA-UNINET Austria (20 members) - ASEA-UNINET, incl. the candidate member University of Arts Linz.

We will notify you again as well as the ASEA-UNINET University Coordinators once the respective calls have officially opened.

For the Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET, we would also like to share a brief application analysis (see attached) from the previous call with National Coordinators who, in addition to this, will be receiving more detailed and country specific data shortly. Perhaps this data could prove useful in optimizing information circulation, and we would encourage all applicable National Coordinators to host info webinars to (i) raise awareness of the grant to prospective applicants and (ii) offer support to them in putting together polished research proposals and applications. Members of the selection committee as well as we at the ASEA-UNINET Network Office have previously provided guidance through workshops (e.g., on how to polish research proposals, application guidance) and could be included in your info webinars given advance notice. We recommend offering webinars starting now throughout the end of the year, as it does typically take time for applicants to contact prospective supervisors and refine their proposal (kindly take note of an earlier deadline for Music Practice Grant applicants by December 15th, 2024).

As always, please be in touch if you have questions or if we may further support you.

We are much looking forward to another successful call with the continued expectation of high-quality applications.

## Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET

Information on Scholarship Call 2025/26 (closing date 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025)

ASEA-UNINET supports the exchange of knowledge between partner universities and member countries in Europe and South-East Asia. In this context, the network supports the exchange of scientists and postgraduates and the transfer of knowledge associated.

The Ernst Mach Grant – ASEA-UNINET offers scholarships for full PhD studies, postdoc research stays and for studies in the field of music practice at an ASEA-UNINET member university\* in Austria to students and researchers **from Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam.**

**Citizenship:** Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam (only applicants who hold the citizenship of one of these countries are eligible to apply)

**Target Country:** Austria

**Area of Study:** All fields of study: Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Human Medicine, Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities

### Types of Grants:

#### Full PhD Grant

**Target Group:** Postgraduates who want to carry out a full doctorate/PhD-programme in Austria and fulfill the requirements for admission and who have completed their studies at a university outside Austria

**Duration:** 36 months

**Grant benefit:** 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro + a mobility subsidy of 300 Euro per month

#### Postdoc Grant

**Target Group:** Postdocs who are involved in teaching and research at an ASEA-UNINET member university\* in Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam

**Duration:** 4 to 9 months

**Grant benefit:** 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro

#### Music Practice Grant

**Target Group:** Undergraduates (or higher) in the field of music practice (instrumental and vocal performance, composition, and conducting)

**Duration:** 9 months

**Grant benefit:** 1,300 Euro per month + a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro

*\*Incl. ASEA-UNINET candidate members*



**Maximum Age:** Undergraduates, Graduates and Postgraduates: 35 years; Postdocs: 45 years

**Funding Organisation:** OeAD-GmbH in cooperation with ASEA-UNINET (on behalf of and financed by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research - BMBWF)

**Language Proficiency:** Very good knowledge of English and/or German

**Selection Process:** After an examination of the formal requirements and an evaluation of the applications by experts, the candidates will be invited to a personal (face-to-face) interview. Applicants for the Music Practice Grant have to participate in an audition process including a mandatory interview (for further information see [here](#)). Final decision by the BMBWF.

**Closing date for applications: 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025** (for Music Practice Grant: 15<sup>th</sup> December 2024)

ASEA-UNINET supports the exchange of knowledge between partner universities and member countries in Europe and South-East Asia. In this context, the network supports the exchange of scientists and postgraduates and the transfer of knowledge associated.

The Ernst Mach – ASEA-UNINET Short-term Research Grant is open to postdocs from **Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Thailand, and Vietnam** who would like to conduct a short research stay in Austria at an ASEA-UNINET member university\* in Austria and who are involved in teaching and/or research at an ASEA-UNINET member university\*.

**Citizenship:** Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam (only applicants who hold the citizenship of one of these countries are eligible to apply)

**Target Country:** Austria

**Area of Study:** All fields of study: Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Human Medicine, Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities

### Grant Details:

**Target Group:** Postdoc researchers who are involved in teaching and/or research at an ASEA-UNINET member university\* in Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Thailand, or Vietnam

**Duration:** 1 or 2 months

**Grant benefit:** 1,300 per month; grant recipients from Cambodia, Laos and Myanmar may also receive a travel costs subsidy of up to 1,200 Euro

**Maximum Age:** Postdocs: 45 years (child-raising periods may be taken into account)

**Funding Organisation:** OeAD-GmbH in cooperation with ASEA-UNINET (on behalf of and financed by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research - BMBWF).

**Language Proficiency:** Very good knowledge of English and/or German.

**Closing date for applications:** ongoing applications (to be submitted 2-9 months prior to planned research stay)

*\*Incl. ASEA-UNINET candidate members*

#### Documents and Uploads to be submitted with the Online Application:

- Written consent of the supervisor at the Austrian host university. Such a written consent may only be issued by a researcher or lecturer who is affiliated with an Austrian ASEA-UNINET member university and who holds a "Venia Docendi", e.g. a Full or Associate Professor.
- Written consent of the ASEA-UNINET coordinator at the cooperating Austrian university.
- Written consent of the ASEA-UNINET coordinator at the cooperating ASEAN university.
- Written consent of the ASEA-UNINET national coordinator of the ASEAN member country. For these letters of consent, no specific form is required; however, they must bear the letterhead, date and signature of the coordinator as well as the stamp of the university/department and must not be older than six months at the time of application.
- Copy of passport
- PhD certificate as well as an English or German translation.
